Skilled Documentation Practical Matter Considering economy and efficiency, skilled services can only be provided. in a SNF Reasons for a skilled SNF stay: Intensity of therapy provided Medical complexity Less than the 24 hour/day care would impose safety risks or an adverse impact on the resident's medical condition.

Checklist: Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) Documentation

There are four principle skilled nursing services that require Medicare charting: 1. Management and Evaluation of a Care Plan. The development, management, and evaluation of a patient care plan, based on the physician's orders and supporting documentation, constitute skilled nursing services.

Nursing Documentation Requirements Under PDPM: What isn't new

Skilled nursing facility (SNF) care Medicare Part A (Hospital Insurance) covers Skilled nursing care provided in a SNF in certain conditions for a limited time (on a short-term basis) if all of these conditions are met: You have Part A and have days left in your Benefit period to use. You have a Qualifying hospital stay.

Medicare Advantage, 1876 Cost, or PACE Plans typically waive the 3-day hospitalization requirement. While MA plans must cover the same number of SNF days available under Original Medicare, they may cover more SNF days than Original Medicare. In addition, MA plans may have different benefit periods. Basic Medicare Requirements The patient requires these skilled services on a daily basis (see §214.5) As a practical matter, considering economy and efficiency, the daily skilled services can be provided only on an inpatient basis in an SNF (see §214.6) Services need to be provided at a SNF level of care

Medicare Charting If a resident's primary payor source is Medicare, nursing staff must document on the medical record once every 24 hours. Some facilities require a nurses note on Medicare residents once each shift.

Most significant are the waiver of the 3-day prior inpatient hospital stay and the 60-day break in spell-of-illness requirements for skilled nursing facility (SNF) Part A benefit eligibility.

Guidance on Documentation for Use of COVID-19 SNF Waivers

Nursing staff must chart on Medicare A residents once every 24 hours. Most facilities divide that charting between day and evening shift. The charting should include vital signs, why the resident is receiving skilled services, and an excellent description of the resident's condition at that time.

I am the nurse manager for a SNF. Your Medicare charting can be dependent on your FI and their guidelines. Essentially your Medicare A & B charting must reflect what dx you are skilling the Resident under. If they are in for a fx hip, you need to document ADLs, transfers, Wt bearing status, pain, ambulation.
