Creating a project scope statement that concisely, clearly, and accurately outlines the project's parameters requires special skills and tools. Yet too frequently, many project stakeholders lack these skills and tools. Because of this, they often create a scope statement developed over weeks instead of days that contains unclear project boundaries, which usually set the stage for scope creep.
